Rally Statistics!

Since it received AKC approval in January 2005, the sport of rally has set records. 8,912 dogs entered rally trials and already 658 trials have been approved for 2005 in January and February alone. By comparison, the first year of AKC agility saw only 23 trials and 2,000 entries. Rally is intended to be a bridge between Canine Good Citizen level of training and regular obedience.
