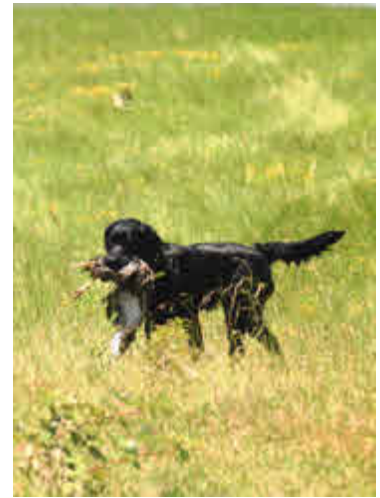
## From the Editor ~
