T-shirt/sweatshirt order forms will be coming in a separate email. I will be taking the orders and if the timing works out right, I will be bring the clothing to the March meeting.

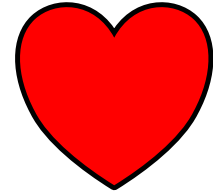
