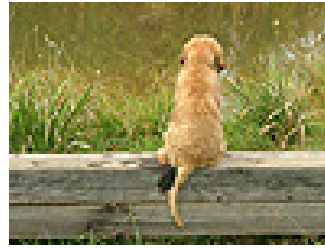

New Business: Marilyn wants to order laminated cards for rally. A motion was made that the club get the required cards, it was voted on and passed.

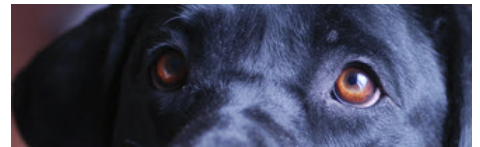
Canine Goods Citizen testing will be done at the Specialty on Saturday July 16th at approximately 10:00 am.

Any member wishing to list a litter on either the website or in the newsletter must provide paper copies of the following minimum documentation:

1- OFA hip certification for the sire and dam

2- OFA elbow certification for the sire and dam

3- Current (12 months) eye clearance (CERF) for the sire and dam

4- A check for \$10.00

5- Contact information for the listing. This may contain one or more of: a persons name, email address, telephone number, kennel name.

6- The choice of web listing, newsletter listing or both. The member may include additional documentation for certifications such as cardiac or EIC. All certifications claimed must be documented. Litter listings will run two (2) months. The member may request one (1) additional month's listing via email. At the end of the run-period the listing will be removed without notice.

Specialty News



Beginner Novice – AKC's newest Optional Titling Obedience Class Cindy Freeman

In July, 2010, AKC introduced its newest titling class, Beginner Novice. The purpose was to encourage to those who have been competing in Rally Obedience to take the next step towards traditional Obedience and is to be used as a stepping stone. The class has some components of Rally and some of obedience. It is broken down into the following exercises:

Heel on leash using Rally signs. The judge does not call out the commands as in Traditional Obedience, but the team is expected to perform the exercises used in a Rally course. The signs used are Start, Left turn, Right turn, About turn, Halt, Fast, Slow, and Finish (not necessarily in that order) The only command the Judge issues is Forward at the start. The exercise is all done on leash.

Figure 8. This is performed as in Traditional Obedience but is done on leash.

Sit for Exam. This is performed on leash and follows the same rules as the Stand for Exam in obedience, only with the handler at the end of a 6 foot leash.

Sit Stay. In this exercise, the handler places the dog in the center of the ring on a stay. The leash remains attached to the dog. The handler then gives the stay comment and walks away from the dog and then walks the complete perimeter of the ring (including behind the dog) and then returns to the front of the dog and directly to heel position.

Recall. This is done on leash using a 6 foot leash. The handler leaves the dog on a stay and then calls the dog to the front position. There is no finish.

We are offering this class at this year's Specialty and it is a lot of fun. For more information, you can find the complete AKC Obedience and Rally regulations at <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RO2999.pdf> in Chapter 6.
