October General Meeting Minutes October 21, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Barb Gilchrist at 7:32 p.m. Motion by Cindy Freeman and seconded by Joanne to accept the minutes of the last meeting as published in the newsletter. Barb said the Cindy submitted a job description for obedience and rally for this month's newsletter and next month Dave & Nicki will submit it for the HRT. These are being published so the new members will understand what is involved in volunteering for jobs at our events. Barb said we had received an email from Retriever News magazine to feature our club's history. The archived history records are no longer available, so Barb left a message for Peggy Campbell and they will put together an outline of the history for the magazine. Nominating committee came up with names to fill the slots and more could be added from the floor in November. They will be printed next month in the newsletter and voted on in January. There are two new board positions open.

Committees: Specialty – Kathy said there is a judge change from Alan Imerman to Judy James for obedience. We have been approved by the National club and the park is reserved. She suggested that since it is our 40th year, we have a BBQ and cake to celebrate. It was discussed and suggested that the club buy the meat and have a BBQ on the Brown Bag day. We will check with Judy to see if it will be at her house on May 12.

HRT – Barb said Nikki was frustrated that we didn't have more club volunteers at the HRT. This spurred us to run the descriptions in the newsletter. Ellen suggested that the club had enough money to hire help. Barb said we trade help with other club's and then we are left owing the other clubs work. Joann suggested a field day with Dave, Marilyn and Nikki to demonstrate HRT jobs at the B-Match. We would need a blind, birds and the winger. Barb will ask Fagundas and Neils about the Sportsman show.

2011 Annual Awards

We will be giving out the Annual Awards at our meeting in January 2012. If your dog has earned an AKC title in the field, obedience or conformation ring during the period of November 2010 through November 2011 and you are an R.C.L.R.C. member of good standing, you are eligible for the "Title" award.

If you have bred the dog, you will receive a "Breeder Award". The owner of the dog shall receive an individual award. Your dog must have finished an American or Canadian Championship, obedience title, hunting title or working certificate to qualify for the "Title" award. Dockdog, Flyball and **UKC titles are also included!**

Dogs that have finished their championship and earned a title in two different performance disciplines (A-F) are eligible for the "All Around" Labrador award.

Dogs are also eligible for the "Versatility" Award or "Certificate of Achievement" Award.

For the "Versatility" Award a dog must earn a working title in two different areas from the following:

- A) Obedience – OTCH, UDX, UD, CDX, or CD – also included are all of the Optional titles
- B) Hunting – FC, AFC, MH, SH or JH
- C) Tracking – VST, TDX or TD
- D) Agility - please identify the title
- E) Rally – RN, RA, RE, RAE
- F) Dock Dogs NJ, JJ, SJ, MJ, EJ

And in addition one certificate from the following:

- G) CGC, TDI, Delta Society, WC, WCX or TT.

For the "Certificate of Achievement" Award a dog must finish any one working title (A-F) and one certificate from the G) listings.

would be for club members only and would not include gossip. Trophy money and volunteers were reasons stated for the group. Any member wishing to list a litter on either the website or in the newsletter must provide paper copies of the following minimum documentation:

- 1- OFA hip certification for the sire and dam
- 2- OFA elbow certification for the sire and dam
- 3- Current (12 months) eye clearance (CERF) for the sire and dam
- 4- A check for \$10.00

5- Contact information for the listing. This may contain one or more of: a persons name, email address, telephone number, kennel name.

6- The choice of web listing, newsletter listing or both. The member may include additional documentation for certifications such as cardiac or EIC. All certifications claimed must be documented. Litter listings will run two (2) months. The member may request one (1) additional month's listing via email. At the end of the run-period the listing will be removed without notice.
