1- OFA hip certification for the sire and dam

2- OFA elbow certification for the sire and dam

3- Current (12 months) eye clearance (CERF) for the sire and dam

4- A check for \$10.00

5- Contact information for the listing. This may contain one or more of: a persons name, email address, telephone number, kennel name.

6- The choice of web listing, newsletter listing or both. The member may include additional documentation for certifications such as cardiac or EIC. All certifications claimed must be documented. Litter listings will run two (2) months. The member may request one (1) additional month's listing via email. At the end of the run-period the listing will be removed without notice.

Meeting was called to order by Barb Gilchrist at 6:35 PM at the home of Susan & Greg Huntzinger.

A motion was made by Joanne Huntley to dismiss the reading of the November Minutes. It was seconded by Deb Neal.

Treasurer's Report: The Bank balance is \$14,745. The month of December has \$165 in income and \$884 in expenses. This was due to expenses still being paid for the specialty and HRT. The total income for the year was \$22,380 and expenses of \$21,107 for a net profit of \$1,273. Greg advised that some of the expenses paid during the year were payments in advance for future events.

Specialty: The paperwork has been submitted to the AKC, but confirmation has not yet been received. Cathy will contact them next week to follow up. Cindy will handle Advertising in LQ and on Wiscoy. B Match: no Report – a chairperson is still needed for the event – the date will be May 13, 2012.
