## Policy and Charges for Newsletter and Web Litter Announcements

Any member wishing to list a litter on either the website or in the newsletter must provide paper copies of the following minimum documentation:

- 1- OFA hip certification for the sire and dam
- 2- OFA elbow certification for the sire and dam
- 3- Current (12 months) eye clearance (CERF) for the sire and dam
- 4- A check for \$10.00
- 5- Contact information for the listing.

This may contain one or more of: a person's name, email address, telephone number, kennel name.

6- The choice of web listing, newsletter listing or both. The member may include additional documentation for certifications such as cardiac or EIC.

All certifications claimed must be documented. Litter listings will run two (2) months. The member may request one (1) additional month's listing via email. At the end of the run-period the listing will be removed without notice.

*Newsletter Guidelines ~ This newsletter is published monthly by the Rose City Labrador Retriever Club a non-profit organization and issued to all members in good standing. Contributions for publication and advertisements are welcome. Advertising rates are \$25.00 per half page and \$50.00 per whole page. All submissions for publication are to be mailed or emailed to the editor by the 25th of the month. All brags are to be current within 90 days of the event. Any photos submitted for publication can be in any format except a PDF. Original photos can be scanned if you mail them to me.*

## 2012 Annual Awards

We will be giving out the Annual Awards at our meeting in January 2013. If your dog has earned an AKC title in the field, obedience or conformation ring during the period of November 2011 through November 2012 and you are an R.C.L.R.C. member of good standing, you are eligible for the “**Title**” award.

If you have bred the dog, you will receive a “**Breeder Award**”. The owner of the dog shall receive an individual award. Your dog must have finished an American or Canadian Championship, obedience title, hunting title or working certificate to qualify for the “**Title**” award. Dockdog, Flyball and **UKC titles are also included!**

Dogs that have finished their championship and earned a title in two different performance disciplines (A-F) are eligible for the “**All Around**” Labrador award.

Dogs are also eligible for the “**Versatility**” Award or “**Certificate of Achievement**” Award.

For the “**Versatility**” Award a dog must earn a working title in two different areas from the following:

- A) Obedience – OTCH, UDX, UD, CDX, or CD – also included are all of the Optional titles
- B) Hunting – FC, AFC, MH, SH or JH
- C) Tracking – VST, TDX or TD
- D) Agility - please identify the title
- E) Rally – RN, RA, RE, RAE
- F) Dock Dogs NJ, JJ, SJ, MJ, EJ

And in addition one certificate from the following:

- G) CGC, TDI, Delta Society, WC, WCX or TT.

For the “**Certificate of Achievement**” Award a dog must finish any one working title (A-F) and one certificate from the (G) listings.

The meeting was called to order at 7:34 by Barb Gilchrist at Meridian Park Hospital in Tualatin, OR.

Judy Chambers motioned to dispense with the reading of the minutes – Joanne Huntley seconded. Motion carried by all in attendance.

AKC is promoting its 4 – 6 month Beginner puppy class. Credits towards the specialty requirements can be earned, but it needs to be held in conjunction with a regular all breed show. Beginning July 3, 2013 points can be earned towards a Certificate of Merit. Judy Chambers mentioned that maybe it would be good at a supported entry. Licensed judges are required.

A WC chair is still needed for the 2013 National. It will be held on one of the days as the HRT. Cindy Freeman volunteered to be chair. Volunteers will be needed to assist.

VP report – none

Secretary – AKC is seeking donations towards a fund to help the canine victims of Hurricane Sandy. Approval was received from AKC for Sweepstakes at the Portland show on Saturday, January 19.

Treasurer report – Greg provided a treasurer's report. HRT financial report is now included, but it is unsure whether all expenses for the HRT are included.

Website expenses – paid in advance for 3 years for the domain name.

Membership report: No new members to report.

Specialty – BaRay is working on the annual contract and will be provided to Blake. In order to cut down on costs, reduce the number of catalogs printed. There were quite a few left over from last year. It was mentioned that some clubs now offer the option to pre order catalogs and not have as many on site to sell. We need to encourage more catalog advertising and possibly look into obtaining other advertising from different businesses in the area.

Committees:

Sportsman's show in February. We need a chair for this event.

All Breed show in January – There will be a Meet the Breed one day. Annual meeting will be held after the show on January 19, 2013 at the Huntzinger's around 5:00.

B- Match – Judy Chambers will do chair the match but cannot do the specialty. She will mentor the next person for the specialty.

Floor nominations: No nominations were made from the floor for the 2013 officers and board.

Judy Chambers suggested that a Motion be made in next newsletter that all positions are unopposed so

there will be no actual voting at the meeting.

New Business: Judy Chambers suggested that we have one of our club members be our show secretary instead of current Superintendent. She mentioned that there is software to do this. The Superintendent is quite expensive. Maybe ask Jane Garvin to just come out and sit at the show and act as show secretary? Need to look into software and possibly setting up PayPal account.

AKC has set up a Hurricane Sandy Fund? Cindy will look for a target for a charitable donation. Judy made a motion to donate \$200 and Ellen Sparks specified that it should be dependent on finding a satisfactory fund with Animal support specific. If one cannot be located, a donation to American Red Cross if no animal fund is found. All members voted in favor.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Susan Huntzinger at 8:15 – Bernie seconded. Motioned carried by all members.
