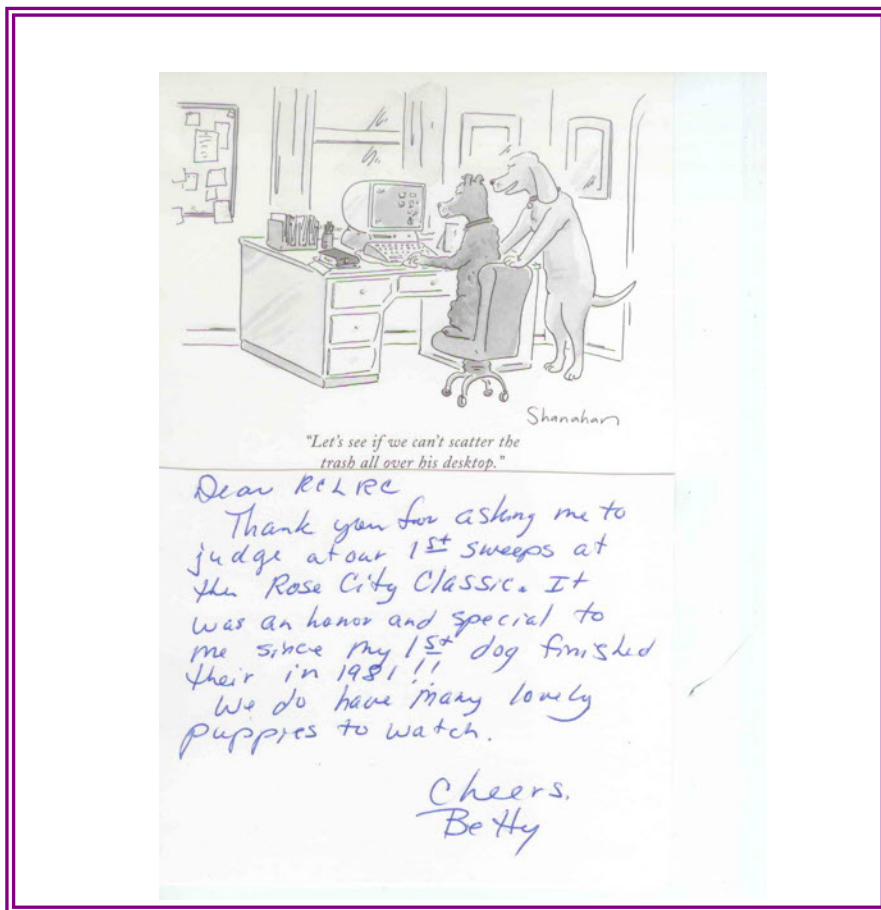


New Policy and Charges for Newsletter and Web Litter Announcements

Any member wishing to list a litter on either the website or in the newsletter must provide paper copies of the following minimum documentation:

- 1- OFA hip certification for the sire and dam
- 2- OFA elbow certification for the sire and dam
- 3- Current (12 months) eye clearance (CERF) for the sire and dam
- 4- A check for \$10.00
- 5- Contact information for the listing. This may contain one or more of: a persons name, email address, telephone number, kennel name.
- 6- The choice of web listing, newsletter listing or both. The member may include additional documentation for certifications such as cardiac or EIC. All certifications claimed must be documented. Litter listings will run two (2) months. The member may request one (1) additional month's listing via email. At the end of the run-period the listing will be removed without notice.

February General Meeting Minutes

February 15, 2013

In attendance: Barb Gilchrist, Cindy Freeman, Sandra Whitman, Dave Illias, Marilyn Parker, Joanne Huntley, Blake Leamy, Elizabeth Moir, Lisa Cruanas, Betty Barkley.

The meeting was called to order at 7:09 PM by Barb Gilchrist at Elmer's in Portland, Oregon.

Presidents Report – Barb did not have a report.

Vice President report: None

Secretary Report: A motion to accept minutes as read was made by Lisa Cruanas. Joanne Huntley seconded. All members approved. Cindy read a notice from Jill Mahoney that the cost of the dinner being hosted by Barb and Bob Gilchrist could be expensive. She suggested that each club should donate \$250 to assist in defraying the costs. Betty Barkley said possibly donations could be requested from people coming to the dinner. A suggestion was made that those attending should RSVP in advance so that the attendance number will be more known. Discussion tabled until the next meeting. A thank you card was received from Betty Barkley for asking her to judge at the Rose City Classic.

Treasurer's Report: Greg was not in attendance, but sent each member his report for January.

Committees:

HRT: Dave Illias reported that the dates will be July 6 & 7. There are new rules about limiting numbers. And there is an Increase in the AKC fee.

WC: Dave reported that 1st & 2nd of June is available. Dave will talk to Jeff about the new access point. There is a new parking lot. June 1st was decided as the date of the event.

Specialty – Blake said that the applications are in to AKC. He followed up with Monique at AKC to confirm receipt. The contract with BaRay has been obtained. He said that he spoke with BaRay about preordering catalogs and that it is not really feasible because of the fees involved. It was discussed that we order fewer since we had so many left over last year. It was decided to order 60 catalogs. We need to push Catalog advertising. ½ page – full page ads. Blake will find out how much BaRay would charge us so we can determine how much to charge. It was suggested that the trophy donation form be put in the March newsletter to start getting donations early. Judges have been contacted. Ribbons will be ordered from Winning Colors. The Photographer is Elaine Rushton. There was discussion as to whether we need one site or 2 sites to provide extra parking slots. Barb feels that it is an expense over and above our allotted costs. Blake will look into asking the park for Saturday only. Advertising needs to go into Lab Quarterly.

B Match: Judy will do it this year and she will help Susie Morrill. The date is May 11, 2013

New Business: January Show supported entry – need to decide on judge for sweeps now. Discussion follows as to whether we want to continue offering sweeps at the Saturday show. Betty motioned that we support Sweepstakes at Portland on Saturday, January 2014. Lisa Cruanas seconded the motion. Any judge can show on Sunday themselves, but may no show their own dogs or be present on Thursday and Friday and may not have an entry on Saturday. Judges were suggested.

Other new Business: Meeting for next month – due to the San Joaquin Specialty, the date is changed to March 22 at the Hospital in Tualatin.

Motion to adjourn at 8:09 was made by Joanne Huntley, and seconded by Marilyn Parker. Motion carried by all members.
