- Marshall for the Master stake both days: Involves having handlers ready to go to the line and keeping the holding blinds full (but not too full). Will do call backs for each stake both days. I have a marshall already for Senior and Junior.
- Bird planters: I usually have kids do this but if anyone would like to give this a try, please let me know. This involves planting blinds for Senior and Master. Need to be able to move quick.
- Pop & throw stations for all stakes both days: This involves handling a popper gun (no live ammunition) and handling the Winger (which is what is used to throw dead ducks).
- Help setting up equipment for the stakes both days.
- Lunch pickup and delivery for workers (all volunteers get a lunch each day) and making sure all Judges and workers have ice chests and drinks.
- Gunners for all stakes: Must be able to hit a moving target.
- Stake Manager for each stake: This person is responsible for making sure all tests are set up to the Judges' requirements and to keep the test flowing smoothly.
- Test dogs for each stake each day.

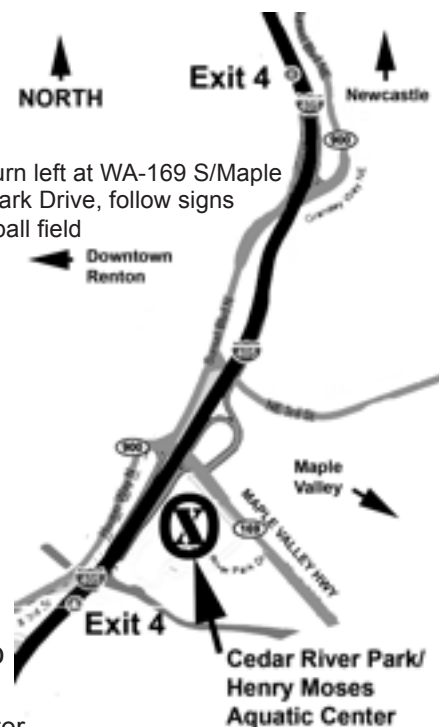

Any member wishing to list a litter on either the website or in the newsletter must provide paper copies of the following minimum documentation:

1. OFA hip certification for the sire and dam
2. OFA elbow certification for the sire and dam
3. Current (12 months) eye clearance (CERF) for sire and dam
4. A check for \$10.00, made out to RCLRC
5. Contact information for the listing. This may contain one or more of: a persons name, email address, telephone number, and kennel name.
6. The choice of web listing, newsletter listing or both. The member may include additional documentation for certifications such as cardiac or EIC. All certifications claimed must be documented. Litter listings will run two months. The member may request one additional month via email. At the end of the run-period the listing will be removed without notice.

Information must be sent to Greg Huntzinger who will then pass the information onto the newsletter editor. Due date is the 25th of each month. Please give your information time to arrive. Send all information to: Greg Huntzinger, 30940 SW Riverlane Road, West Linn, OR 97068
