- 1 - OFA hip certification for the sire and dam
- 2 - OFA elbow certification for the sire and dam
- 3 - Current (12 months) eye clearance (CERF) for the sire and dam
- 4 - A check for \$10.00 made out to RCLRC
- 5 - Contact information for the listing. This may contain one or more of a person's name, email address, telephone number and kennel name.
- 6 - The choice of web listing, newsletter listing or both. The member may include additional documentation for certifications such as cardiac or EIC.

All certifications claimed must be documented. Litter listings will run two (2) months. The member may request one (1) additional month via email. At the end of the run period the listing will be removed without notice.

Information must be sent to Greg Huntzinger who will then pass the information on to the newsletter editor. Due date is the 25th of each month. Please give your information time for processing. Send all information to:

# HUNT TEST INFORMATION

The Hunt Test is right around the corner. This is the first year of the date change which will be July 27 and 28. Since it is no longer the weekend before the specialty I don't want to hear that as an excuse! As with any event, this cannot run itself - it takes a village. It is a great way to come and watch dogs work doing what they love and were bred to do.

The following are some of jobs that we need filled:

**Hospitality** - helping by picking up sandwiches each day that Marilyn Parker orders for the lunches and then helping put them in bags to deliver to the grounds and to be delivered to the workers and judges each day. Depending on how hot it is, this could also involve running to the store for more ice since I cannot leave to do that once I am on the grounds. The same person does not have to do this each day.

**Setup and take down** - For those who are early birds, if you could come early each day to help move equipment and set it up, it would only be a partial day job. Same for take down on Sunday. Once we know what the entries are, I can give an estimate on when you would be required to be there. If you have truck or vehicle that be used to move equipment that would be a bonus!

**Working in a Pop and Throw** (winger station with dead birds) - if we can get enough volunteers, this job could be split in half into 1st series and 2nd series. Again, once we see the numbers, we will know more about times for this.

New this year - it was suggested that we have one or two greeters. The following is the job description and we would provide a script to follow.

**Greeter ~ 1 or 2 volunteers** - 2 would keep each other company:-))) to be there early (time to be determined) out at the Check Station entrance or for sure where ever the Junior/Senior Stakes

would be entering.

**Welcome participants!**

**Discuss parking rules for the Island per Fisheries & Wildlife Guidelines**

**Where the Port a potties are located**

**Location of stakes**

**If they are super early, to please wait in a parking lot ( time to be specified)**

**Give 1 or 2 Raffle Tickets and inform about the Raffle and where it will be located**

**Remind them to keep the grounds clean and where the dumpster will be**

**Remind Junior Stake folks to check in with Marshalls**

**Ask everyone if they have any questions? ( if greeters don't know answers, they could contact a committee member)**

**Wish everyone a great day, good luck and most importantly have fun!!**

If anyone has a quad (4 wheeler) that could be used, that would also be great! We had one last year and it was very beneficial, but we won't have it this year. It is very nice to be able to easily run from stake to stake without having to drive a car/van/truck.
